The Claisebrook Cove inlet which is located off the Swan River, provides an interesting focal point for the redevelopment, with the streets surrounding the Cove featuring the standard Urbanstone commercial PCC paving units. The public walk ways on the banks of the inlet, either side of the Plain Street traffic bridge, have been paved in contrasting Topaz and New Amber paving units.

Mr Pullyblank added that Urbanstone had provided an additional safety feature - their pavers are cast with flush-fitting edges to avoid the possibility of dangerous gaps.
